

Outreach Worker – TransPower Program

Queer Works, a 501c (3), is looking to bring on an Outreach Worker to the "TransPower" project. The individual will be part of a 4-person team, working in the field providing "curbside" linkage to ongoing mental health care and social services to Transgender and Non-Binary individuals living the Palm Springs/Cathedral City/Indio area.

This contract is until July 1st, with possibility of extension based on project renewal. The Outreach Worker will work 10-15 hours a week at a rate of \$18-20 an hour (DOE). Looking to start ASAP.
